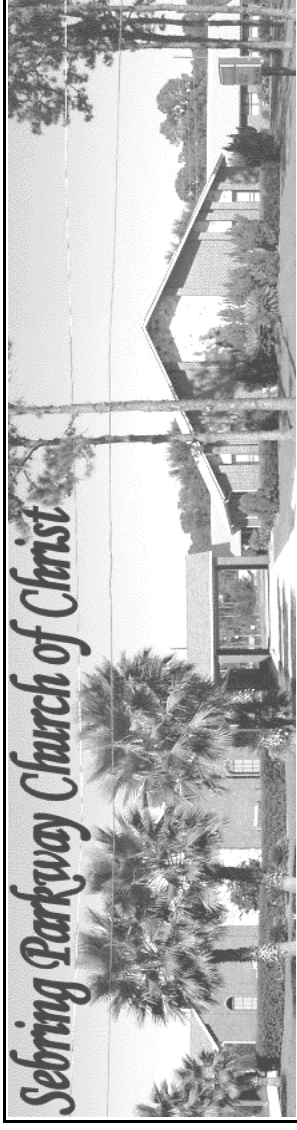

WHO'S TO BLAME?

A young married couple was contacted by some church members. The members invited the couple to attend Bible classes and worship services. This is a record of their response:

On the first visit: "We are going to start as soon as the baby gets old enough to come. Thank you so much for your visit! It's great to know that there are Christians who care!"

Three years later: "We know you think we are awful, but Janie cries and throws a fit and doesn't want to go so we hate to force her. Our parents forced us to go to church when we were her age. We don't want to make the same mistake with our little angel. Don't worry, we will come when Janie is old enough to understand what church is about. But thank you for visiting!"

Eleven years later: "We're glad you called. We hope you or someone else from church will speak to Janie. She is beginning to run around with the wrong crowd. Perhaps if the church could provide her with some kind of entertainment for her age group she wouldn't be in this mess. Do you have someone there at church who does family counseling?"

Three years later: "Yes, Janie just had a baby of her own. We're not old enough to be grandparents. Janie is so social. We get to watch the baby all weekend sometimes. She is thinking about marrying the father. They are awfully young and he is not a Christian. But we think things will work out."

Ten years later: "Well Janie has finally married a man who can give her the better things in life. This is her third husband, but she could not get along with the other two. We had hoped that this one would become a member of the church, but the preacher preached a sermon on marriage and divorce and he says he'll never attend that church again. There must be something wrong with the church or it would have had a better influence on Janie. Maybe they need to change preachers. I don't know..."

Who's to blame for Janie's predicament? Is it the church? Perhaps the church should have sent more members more often to this family. But I think you can discern who is really to blame.

I can assure you from my experiences that the above scenario occurs far too often. I know of parents right who are making the mistake of not being serious about the Lord and His church (Matt. 6:33), and then their children grow up not knowing the Lord. Sadly, and again, far too often, parents are not even alarmed when their children grow up and have children outside of marriage or change spouses like they change jobs or automobiles (and seemingly with less thought).

Parents! Please consecrate yourselves to God! Bring your kids to Bible classes and worship services every time. While there is time, "force" them to be in church. Be genuine and true in living the Christian life! Read Eph. 6:1-4. You will never be sorry.
