### *Attitude Adjustment*

When God says something once in Scripture, it is important, else he would not have given it. But when God says something over and over, we should really pay attention. God is quite clear and very specific when he commands believers; **“Do all things without grumbling or disputing.” (Phil. 2:14).**

In I Corinthians 10, God describes five failures of the Israelites, as examples to warn believers of five things that can cause us to lose our salvation. Do not lust after evil things (v. 6), do not become an idolater (v.7), do not commit sexual immorality (v. 8), do not tempt Christ (v. 9), **AND DO NOT GRUMBLE** (v. 10).

After God’s call for Moses to deliver the people from Egyptian bondage, Moses went before Pharaoh to tell him to let God’s people go (Exodus 5:1). Pharaoh not only refused, but made their work harder. The leaders of Israel then went before Pharaoh to appeal the edict but Pharaoh refused to listen.

As the elders of Israel came out from Pharaoh, then turned to Moses and said, **“May the Lord look upon you and judge you, for you have made us odious in Pharaoh’s sight and in the sight of his servants, to put a sword in their hand to kill us.”** (5:21)

Then Moses returned to the Lord and said, **“O Lord, why hast thou brought harm to this people? Why didst thou ever send me? Ever since I came to Pharaoh to speak in thy name, he has done harm to this people; and thou hast not delivered thy people at all.”** (5:22-23)

#### **MURMURING DISCOURAGES OTHERS**

The first consequence of murmuring is discouragement. Moses wanted to do God’s will, but when the officers of Israel murmured against him, Moses became discouraged and questioned God’s will for his life.

#### **MURMURING IS CONTAGIOUS**

As a result of Israel’s complaining, Moses complained. It always breeds more. It is like a cancer—it keeps growing.

#### **MURMURERS LOVE COMPANY**

Murmurers often operate in groups. In the Gospels it is always the scribes, the Pharisees, or the Sadducees murmuring against Jesus. (Luke 5:30; 15:2; 19:7; John 6:41).

God delivered Israel from slavery but did they stop their murmuring? **No!** They always found something to complain about. The water was bitter, where’s the beef(?), then there was not enough water.

#### **MURMURING IS SIN**

What then will keep us from murmuring? In Exodus 16:8, Moses says to the people, **...“for the Lord hears your grumblings which you grumble against him...Your grumblings are not against us (Moses and Aaron) but against the Lord.”** Murmuring is against God, not man. Murmuring is sin.
