Born in St. Louis on Dec. 19, 1958, Doug grew up mostly in small towns in eastern Missouri where his Dad preached for several small churches.

Doug graduated from Freed-Hardeman University with a BS in Education then later earned a Master of Ministry degree from FHU. After graduation he moved to Miami where he coached for two years, attending South Miami Church of Christ (*now Sunset*), volunteering in Youth work there. He next moved to North Little Rock where he was employed at Central Arkansas Christian School where he taught Bible and coached Volleyball, Basketball and Track.

Judy was born in Memphis but grew up in Jacksonville. She graduated from Harding in '84 with a BA in education. It was in Little Rock that Doug & Judy met and married in '86. She currently teaches school. They have two children. Kristen Nicole, 19, and Daniel Benjamin, 16. Kristen is in college and Daniel is a HS sophomore who enjoys tennis.

Doug Yates began full-time church work in 1987, having worked in Children's Ministry, Youth Ministry, Family Ministry, College Ministry, Young Adult Ministry, Outreach/Involvement/Church Growth Ministry and always working with the Educational needs of the church. He says his Mom and Dad were most influential in his life. They would move to a town where the church was either non-existent or very weak; working with them till they were self-supporting, then move on to another town and start all over, establishing churches in several towns this way. His Dad recently retired as preacher for the Highway 5 North Church of Christ in Mountain View, Arkansas. His mother died of lymphoma in 2000. The Kingdom of God owes much to such families as this. Doug has an older brother who preaches at Salem, Arkansas and his sister is married to a preacher who preaches in Mississippi.

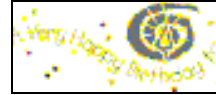

The Mind of Christ

“Christ gives us a perfect example to follow: (Phil 2:3-8). His high standard was not given to frustrate us, but to reveal areas in our lives that need improvement.

HE WAS SELFLESS. “Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind let each of you regard one another as more important than himself: do not merely look out for your own personal interest, but also for the interests of others” (vv. 3,4).

HE WAS SECURE. “Who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men” (vv. 6,7).

HE WAS SUBMISSIVE. “And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross” (v. 8).

Paul says that these qualities were exhibited in the life of Christ because of His attitude (v. 5). He also says that we can have this same attitude in our lives.
